**Subject:** Loyaltton- USDA Funded Purchases

The purpose of this e-mail is to provide the City with documentation of USDA's position concerning two items that pertain to the recent expenditures made utilizing USDA funding. During a site visit on November 6, 2018 we were notified that an engine block heater that will be required for the newly acquired backhoe was inadvertently omitted from the purchase. The City should move forward and acquire this item as soon as possible so that it can be used for the upcoming winter.

We were also informed that the portable pump that was recently purchased is not the most appropriate type for the operation and maintenance of the City's wastewater system. (It is my understanding that the pump can be readily exchanged for pumps that are more suitable.) The City should therefore move forward and make the required exchange. It will not be necessary to provide this agency with any documentation of the exchange provided the new pumps will be primarily utilized for the wastewater system.
