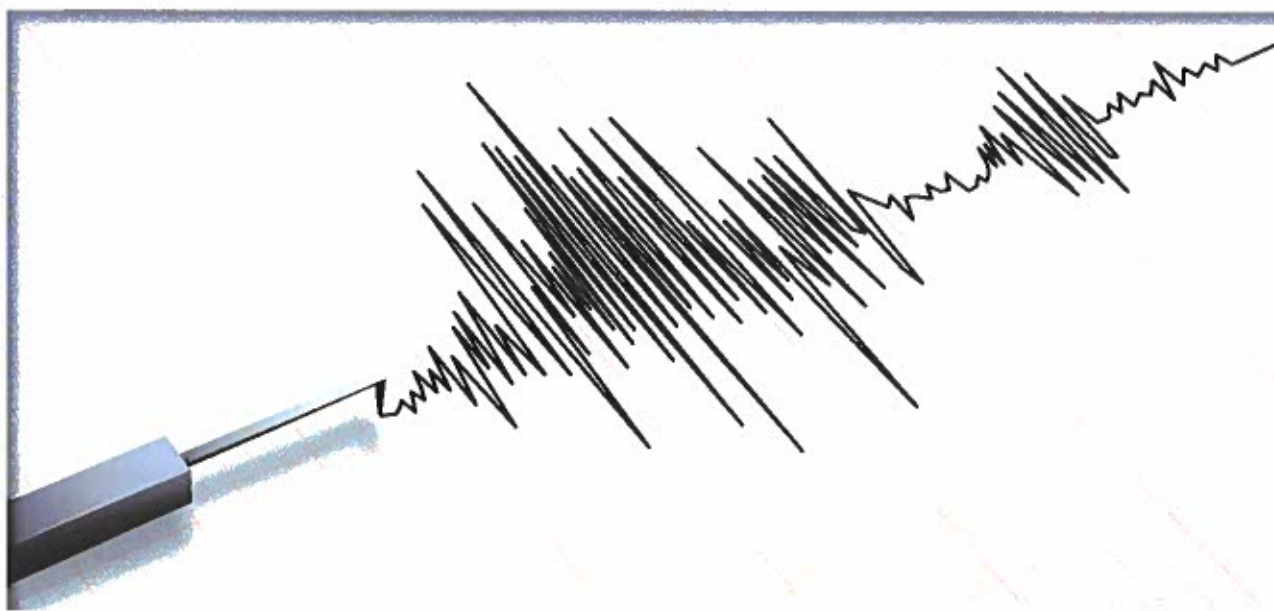

Local shaking intensity is measured in G-Forces (percent of gravity). The higher the G-Forces, the more likely the infrastructure damage, lost revenue, etc.

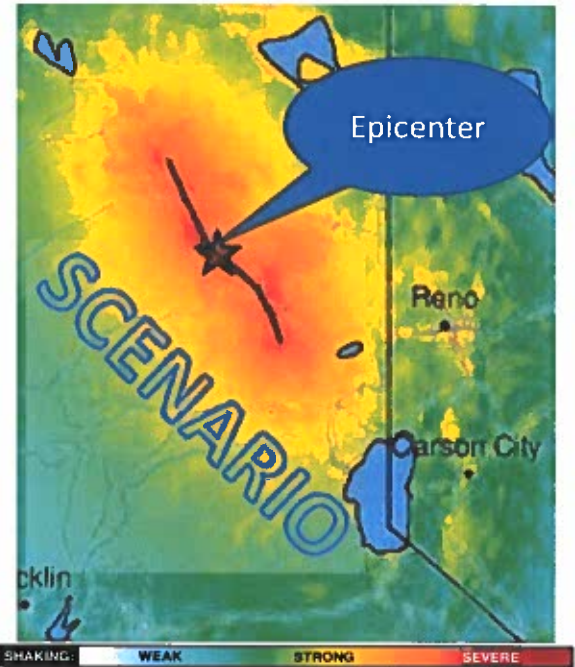

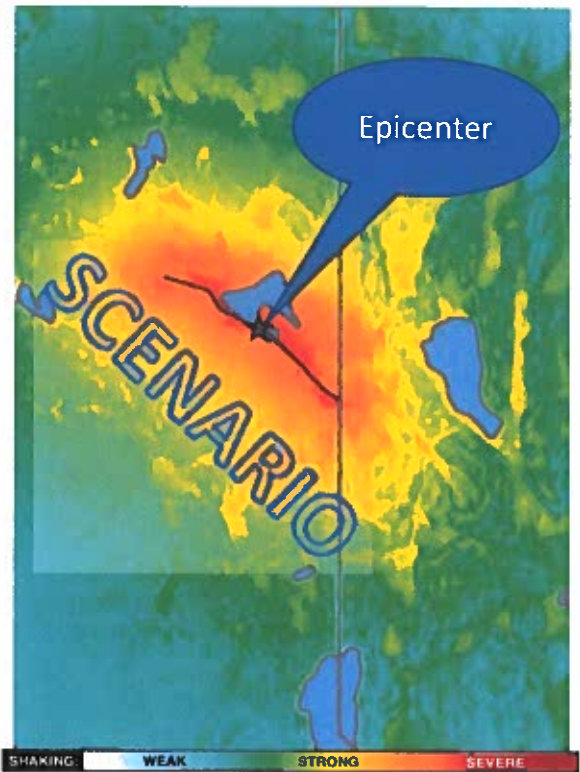
When preparing for emergencies, utilities, local governments, and other organizations get the best results by running training drills based on realistic earthquake situations—ones that match what could actually happen in their area.

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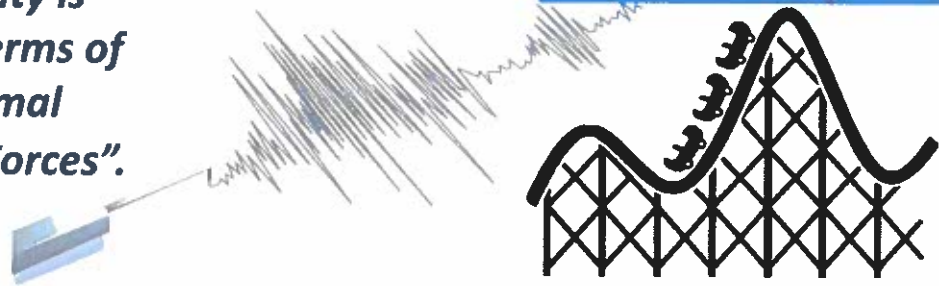
## How is shaking intensity measured?



*The United States Geological Survey (USGS) will capture data from dozens of seismic stations and calculate shaking intensity for 100's of Lat / Long points in the affected area. This is called a Shakemap*



**Shaking intensity is expressed in terms of percent of normal gravity or "G-Forces".**



Shaking Intensity (PSA0.3)	Description/Damage
10	Felt only by a few persons at rest, especially on upper floors of buildings.
15	Felt indoors by many, outdoors by few during the day. At night, some awakened. Dishes, windows, doors disturbed; walls make cracking sound. Sensation like heavy truck striking building. Standing motor cars rocked noticeably.
30	Felt by nearly everyone; many awakened. Some dishes, windows broken. Unstable objects overturned. Pendulum clocks may stop.
50	Felt by all, many frightened. Some heavy furniture moved; a few instances of fallen plaster. Damage slight.
90	Damage negligible in buildings of good design and construction; slight to moderate in well-built ordinary structures; considerable damage in poorly built or badly designed structures; some chimneys broken.
115	Damage slight in specially designed structures; considerable damage in ordinary substantial buildings with partial collapse. Damage great in poorly built structures. Fall of chimneys, factory stacks, columns, monuments, walls. Heavy furniture overturned.
150	Damage considerable in specially designed structures; well-designed frame structures thrown out of plumb. Damage great in substantial buildings, with partial collapse. Buildings shifted off foundations.
150+	Some well-built wooden structures destroyed; most masonry and frame structures destroyed with foundations. Rails bent.
